

Davidoff to Lead Seminar on Tax/IRS Matters

E. Martin Davidoff, a certified public accountant and tax attorney in Dayton, will present a seminar entitled “Window into the IRS” before a group of tax professionals on Friday, January 25, 2008 at Bergen Community College.

Davidoff, owner of E. Martin Davidoff & Associates, specializes in tax controversy work which involves representing his clients before tax authorities to resolve disputes. During the seminar, he will take participants on a journey into a case study about the IRS Offer in Compromise (OIC) program with which he has extensive experience. Through the OIC program, taxpayers with substantial debt can offer to pay a specified sum of money based on their financial situation, hoping the IRS will accept that amount to absolve the entire debt. Although the IRS does not accept all offers in compromise, Davidoff’s success rate of more than 90% is substantially higher than the national average.

At another session entitled “Navigating the IRS,” he will deliver practical tools to enable the tax professionals to effectively represent their clients before the IRS, from the first phone call through problem resolution. He shares sample documents and letters which have proven successful for years, and provides contacts at the IRS for professionals to resolve their cases.

A criminal tax attorney will join Davidoff on the panel to offer tips for avoiding IRS criminal investigations. Lawrence S. Horn, Esq., with the law firm Sills, Cummis & Gross, specializes in white collar criminal investigations. He will stress the importance of being knowledgeable about the agency’s voluntary disclosure policy and properly handling sensitive “eggshell” audits to reduce the chances of a visit from IRS investigators.
